Located high above the fog, on the mountain slopes Napa Valley's majestic Atlas Peak, the Acumen estate features 116 sustainable and organically certified acres of vines, spread across two remarkable vineyards. From these coveted grapes, the Acumen team crafts estate-grown wines, with a focus on mountain-grown Cabernet Sauvignon and Sauvignon Blanc. Taking their inspiration from the legendary Napa Valley wines of the 1960s and 1970s, Acumen's classically structured wines have earned acclaim for their beauty, balance and age-worthiness.

Acumen's two estate vineyards, Attelas and Edcora, offer a rich and vibrant tapestry of vineyard blocks, with a focus on exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon and Sauvignon Blanc, as well as Merlot, Malbec, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. This provides the Acumen team with a remarkable palette of fruit during blending, adding to the layered sophistication of the wines.

Today, Attelas and Edcora are stewarded by master Viticulturist John Derr, who has farmed acclaimed vineyards for Kapcsandy Family Winery, Blankiet Vineyards and Gamble Family Vineyards. Working closely with gifted Vineyard Manager Jesus Gonzalez, John applies his decades of winegrowing experience to the goal of establishing Acumen as Napa Valley's next great wine estate. "Atlas Peak is one of Napa Valley's great mountain AVAs," says John. "And, Acumen's estate vineyards will one day be considered among the world's finest—they are already on the cusp of being Grand Cru-caliber sites."
