TASTING NOTES

A yellow-gold color with aromas of white honeysuckle, acacia flowers, apple blossoms and lemon zest on the nose. On the palate, flavors of Meyer lemon tart, ruby red grapefruit, lemon verbena, gooseberries, white strawberries, wet rocks, lemongrass, honeycomb, and d'Anjou pear coupled with an excellent round mouthfeel and bright acidity with a long and persistent finish.

2013 VINTAGE NOTES

A warm, dry spring brought early bud break and created ideal conditions for flowering and fruit set. Even weather through the summer months allowed for very healthy vines with moderate vigor and berry size going in to veraison. Harvest began earlier than normal, but with great hang time due to the early flower and fruit set. We had cool, sunny weather through harvest allowing for ideal pick dates with above average yields of excellent quality.
