His winegrowing experience throughout Napa Valley, and specifically on Atlas Peak, makes him the ideal person to work with our in-house team as we continue our mission to create the finest vineyard program on Atlas Peak. John is also universally respected in the industry, which will make him an invaluable asset to our grower relations program."

Since its founding in 2012, Acumen has been dedicated to establishing Napa Valley's next great wine estate. To achieve this goal, Acumen acquired two coveted vineyards on Atlas Peak, in the famed eastern mountain of Napa Valley. Named Attelas and Edcora, Acumen's estate vineyards range in elevation from 1,300 to 1,600 feet, and are planted with a focus on Cabernet Sauvignon and the four other red Bordeaux varieties. Originally planted in 1992, the 32-acre Attelas Vineyard was the 'home vineyard' of legendary winegrower Dr. Jan Krupp, and predates his famed Stagecoach Vineyard by three years. Edcora Vineyard, which includes 84 acres of vines, is higher up on Atlas Peak, and is the warmer of the two properties. Two different vintages of Acumen's limited-production PEAK Edcora Cabernet Sauvignon have earned 100-point scores, and grapes from Acumen's estate vineyards are regularly purchased by such iconic wineries as Spottswoode and Chappellet. Because of the limited

nature of Acumen's wines, the winery uses less than 25% of its estate fruit each vintage for the production of Acumen wines.

"Atlas Peak is one of the most exciting regions in Napa Valley for mountain-grown Cabernet Sauvignon," says Derr. "What Acumen has already achieved on Atlas Peak is quite remarkable, and I am excited to work alongside Phillip and Jesus to take Acumen's winegrowing to even greater heights."
